This Enterprise Alternate Contract Source No. 43210000-26-OMNIA-ACS-TX, Technology Solutions, Products and Services (“Term Contract”), is between the **Department of Management Services** (“Department”), an agency of the State of Florida, located at 4050 Esplanade Way, Tallahassee, FL 32399; and **Thundercat Technology, LLC** (“Contractor”), located at 11190 Sunrise Valley Drive, Suite 200, Reston, VA, 20191; collectively referred to herein as the “Parties.”

WHEREAS, section 287.042(16), Florida Statutes (F.S.) authorizes the Department to evaluate contracts let by the Federal Government, another state, or a political subdivision for the provision of commodities and contract services;

WHEREAS, the Region 4 Education Service Center (ESC) of Texas, competitively procured Technology Solutions, Products and Services and executed contract No. R250609, Technology solutions, Products and Services (“Master Contract”), with the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 287.042(16), F.S., the Secretary evaluated the Master Contract and determined that use of the Master Contract is cost-effective and the best value to the state.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Term and Effective Date.

The Master Contract became effective on March 1, 2026, and its term currently ends on February 28, 2029. The Master Contract has two (2) years of renewals available. This Term Contract will become effective on April 7, 2026 or on the date signed by all Parties, whichever is later. This Term Contract will expire on February 28, 2029, unless terminated earlier or renewed in accordance with the Exhibit C, Enterprise Standard Terms and Conditions.

2. Order of Precedence.

This contract document and the attached exhibits constitute the Term Contract and the entire understanding of the Parties. This contract document, Exhibits A, B, and C constitute the Participating Addendum to the Master Contract and modify or supplement the terms and conditions of the Master Contract. All exhibits listed below are incorporated into this Term Contract by reference herein. In the event of a conflict, the following order of precedence shall apply:

Where the laws and regulations of a state other than the State of Florida are cited or referenced in the Master Contract, such citation or reference shall be replaced by the comparable Florida law or regulation.

3. Purchases off this Contract.

Upon execution of this Term Contract, agencies, as defined in section 287.012, F.S., may purchase products and services under this Term Contract. Any entity making a purchase off of this Term Contract acknowledges and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of this Term Contract. The Contractor shall adhere to the terms included in any contract or purchase orders issued pursuant to this Term Contract.
